City of Carlos:

Water/Sewer Services: Call **320-852-3000** to set up water/sewer services. A **\$30.00 deposit** is required when moving into any property in Carlos. Please visit **City Hall** to make your deposit and complete the application. Water meters are electronically read around the **30th of each month**, and payment is due by the **5th of the following month**. Late fees will be applied if payment is not received by the due date.

Building Permits: If you plan to make changes to your property—such as adding an addition or garage, installing a fence, storage shed, or pouring cement for any reason—please contact **City Hall** at **320-852-3000** first. A permit may be required prior to starting your project within city limits.

Brush Pile: The City of Carlos maintains a **brush pile** for citizens to use, located by the lagoon area on the north edge of town. This facility is for **Carlos residents only** and may only be used for **approved yard waste materials**. Unauthorized use will result in fines.

Dog Ordinance: The City of Carlos has a dog ordinance. If you own a dog, please complete an application for each dog. There is a **\$10.00 annual fee** per dog. You must also provide a current copy of the dog's rabies vaccination certificate, which is required.

Chicken Ordinance: City ordinance prohibits farm animals within the city limits.

Winter Weather: City ordinance requires all residents to keep sidewalks free of snow and ice during winter weather.
